GENERAL: Any violation of these rules in any respect may be cause for disqualification. Interpretation and enforcement of such rules rests solely with the Tournament Director, whose decision is final and binding. The Tournament Director reserves the right to request a polygraph exam of any and all participants. Should a polygraph be given, the contestant must pass the polygraph exam in order to receive prizes, cash or products that he or she is entitled. Anyone who refuses to take a polygraph will immediately be disqualified. All Federal, State and local laws must be obeyed and it is the contestant's responsibility to know these laws.

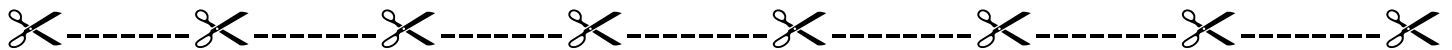
PARTICIPANTS & ELIGIBILITY: The tournament is open to anyone in good standing with Majestic Outdoors, with a valid fishing license and a paid entry fee.

ENTRY FEE AND PAYBACKS: The Entry Fee will be \$125 per boat, which consists of 1 or 2 people. Boat numbers will be assigned by the Tournament Director, upon full payment of entry fee. Big Fish Fee is included with your paid Entry Fee. Paybacks will be calculated on the rate of one place for every seven boats.

REGISTRATION: Contestants may pre-register or register in person at the tournament location. Registrations will be taken at the launch site up to 30 minutes after tournament start time. Boat numbers will be determined by the order of registration.

SCORING: Only Largemouth Bass, Spotted Bass and Smallmouth Bass will be counted. Total stringer weight per team will determine place. The net weight of one bass will determine Big Bass winner. To be counted, a bass must be 12" in length. Short fish will not be counted and carry a 1 pound penalty if brought to the official bump sink. A 5 fish per team limit of bass may be weighed in. Each contestant is expected to take the utmost care of his fish so that all living bass may be returned to the lake. There is a 1/2 pound, or .50 on our scales, penalty for a dead bass weighed in. ONLY one dead bass is allowed to be weighed in. NO "cold", iced or stringer fish will be weighed and any such fish brought in will result in disqualification from the tournament. To be weighed, bass must be turned over to a tournament official. Upon completion of weigh-in, all fish (with the exception of trophy fish) become the responsibility of Majestic Outdoors to facilitate a release program.

WEIGH-IN & WEIGH-IN LOCATIONS: Weigh-in will begin at a specified time decided by the Tournament Director. No fish can be weighed before that time. Only the Tournament Director will determine the closing of the weigh-in scales. Weigh-in location will be determined the day of the tournament and will be announced prior to the start of tournament.
